POSITION/EMPLOYMENT OPPORTUNITY: Open AGR Statewide

MINIMUM APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS: Ability to diversified work with tools and equipment, requiring extreme caution in maintaining close dimensions. Ability to diagnose trouble and determine remedy where overall knowledge of all systems of aircraft is required. Ability to inspect aircraft, determine mechanical deficiencies and analyze results. Ability to interpret instructional material, schematics and specifications for complex mechanical problems on assigned aircraft.

POSITION DESCRIPTION: The primary purpose of this position is to accomplish on and off equipment maintenance on aircraft systems and components such as wheel and tire, flight control, canopies, landing gear, and perform general heavy airframe maintenance, beyond the capability of other maintenance activities. Provides capability for the recovery and reclamation of equipment of damaged or crashed aircraft. Uses tools of the trade to perform maintenance and repair of aircraft and installed equipment. Replaces parts, accessories and major components. Troubleshoots aircraft systems to determine cause of malfunctions and extent of repairs needed. Performs periodic and special inspection to determine that aircraft are ready for flight. Uses technical publications, schematics, and specifications.

APPLICATION PROCEDURE:

A. Applicants are being accepted for Active/Guard Reserve (AGR) Tour/Duty under Title 32, Section 502f, United States Code. The initial tour will be for a three (3) year period unless otherwise prohibited by regulation. If non-mos qualified, individual will become MOS qualified within first year of appointment. Ref: AR 600-5.

1. APPLICATION PACKAGE

- a. One **original** NGB Form 34-1 (Application for Active Guard/Reserve Position)
- b. **Certified** copy of DA Form 2-1 or DA Form 2 as appropriate.
- c. Copy of current physical (SF 88/93 and/or DD Form 2808). Current Periodic last five years may be submitted. Copy of Body Content worksheet (DD 5500 or DD 5501) if applicable.
- d. Copy of DD Form 214 and any other official documentation to verify prior active service.
- e. Copy of latest three (3) NCOER/OERs.
- f. Copy of most recent PT Scorecard (DA Form 705) but not to exceed 12 months old.
- g. Copy of Drivers License.
- h. Copy of PQR.

2. MEDICAL STATUS - If you have had any significant change in medical status, since last physical, attach a separate statement explaining changes in medical status or medical treatment received since last physical examination.
