

ARNG Safety Program Performance Report  
FY 02

**Overview:** The ARNG experienced 95 Class A through C accidents by the close of FY 02. Ground accidents accounted for 81 of which 21 were Class A's. Aviation accidents accounted for 14; there were four Class A aviation accidents.

**Ground.** Ground Class A accidents resulted in the loss of nineteen soldiers and one civilian in FY 02. Ground fatalities occurred in the following types of accidents:

Eleven Privately Owned Vehicles  
Five Personal Injury  
Three Army Motor Vehicle Accidents

POV accidents continue to be the number one killer of ARNG soldiers. Fifty-five percent of the total military ground related fatalities in FY 02 resulted from POV accidents. Personal Injuries accounted for 25 percent and Army motor vehicle accidents accounted for 15 percent of fatal accidents.

**Aviation.** There were four Class A aviation accidents. One of the Class As resulted in a fatality.

**Accident Costs.** The ground accident costs at the end of FY 02 was \$6.3M. The associated aviation costs at the end of the fiscal year was \$85.2M.
