

MEMORANDUM FOR SEE DISTRIBUTION

SUBJECT: Corrected Copies of the 2002 Title 10 AGR Enlisted Promotion Boards

1. Reference NGR 600-200, chapter 11 paragraph 43(f) gives the Military Personnel Office (in this case NGB-ARZ-T) the authority to make corrections to current promotion lists as necessary, to reflect administrative errors detected after the initial release. Each year as errors are detected and corrected or when additional control grades become available, such corrected (phase) lists are released (enclosure 1).

2. Based upon the projected increase in enlisted AGR control grade authorizations for the entire ARNG, we are anticipating few if any, additional Title 10 AGR control grades for the remainder of the 2002-promotion cycle. All sergeant major and master sergeant promotions are based upon the availability of control grades. Therefore, this release is based solely upon corrections to the original promotion lists. None of the corrections resulted in additional promotions or administrative reductions.

3. Additionally, per directive of the ARNG leadership, master sergeants who were boarded for sergeant major on the 2002 SGM Promotion List and were not selected for promotion, and scored above 800 points, may submit a DA Form 4187 requesting attendance at the United States Army, Sergeant Major Academy. Due to the needs of the service, availability of PCS funds and resident school seats, attendance as a resident student at the USASMA will be limited. Requests for resident status will be decided on a case by case basis.

a. All eligible master sergeants interested in this opportunity should submit a DA Form 4187 (see example at enclosure 2) through their NCO Support Channel to NGB-ARZ-T no later than 6 January 2003. All approved master sergeants will receive either a corresponding studies enrollment or resident status confirmation on or before 1 March 2003.

b. Selection for attendance at the USASMA under this program should not be construed as indicative of promotion to sergeant major. Promotion to sergeant major is based solely upon receipt of a sequence number on the SGM Promotion List and confirmed by the receipt of promotion orders from NGB-ARZ-T. Soldiers will continue to submit promotion packets for subsequent promotion cycles.

c. This is strictly a voluntary program, soldiers meeting the eligibility standards are encouraged to participate, however it is solely the decision of each individual soldier. Soldiers not wishing to participate will not be disadvantaged on subsequent promotion boards or assignment considerations.

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d. Each soldier eligible for this training opportunity should carefully consider whether or not their individual work and life style will allow sufficient time to complete the course in the allotted time period. Dismissal due to academic failure, APFT/height/weight non-compliance or being dropped from the course for lack of progress will prohibit future consideration for attendance and promotion. This is a once in a career opportunity. Exceptions to this policy will be for medical and/or circumstances beyond the control of the soldier, to be determined by NGB-ARZ-T on a case by case basis.
